I was stunned. I didn't know any Arabs and had never really had an interest in them. Why would God say that to me, of all people. I knew His main call on my life was to minister emotional healing prayers to suffering believers. What was He saying

It was almost 20 years later when I was first invited to go to the Middle East. I made several trips with other ministries and traveled to one country after another.

My heart began to really grow for the suffer-

ing there. Especially for the women who are so terribly abused.

I have traveled there once a year for about 7 years now. The suffering is great. My heart has continued to grow for these souls.

Oh, yes, I am still in full-time ministry in America as well. Two training seminars will be done this year in Texas and California. God has simply added another dimension to Philippian Ministries. Over 2000 of our books, Help for Hurting Hearts are now floating around in the Middle East. They are filled with the gospel and with help for wounded hearts.

God is giving us a gift. It is reasonable to say that the doctrine of Islam is an enemy of Christianity. The Koran makes it so, but God has promised blessing for those who bless their enemies. We choose to bless!

Egypt is Added to Lana's Middle East Travel 2017

Lana was recently contacted by her key people in Lebanon about returning to the Middle East in the fall (September/October). They asked if she would consider adding Egypt to her trip this year. After praying about it, she felt that God wanted her to minister in Egypt as well as Lebanon and Jordan this year. Her response was, "Yes, if God provides, I will come to Egypt, too."

The Christians in Lebanon have agreed to work at getting her book across the border to Egypt so it can be available at each place where she shares her testimony. There will be 100 to 200 women at each place she travels to speak. That is a wonderful number considering that we are talking about many Muslim women. We are so excited for this new opportunity to speak salvation and healing to hurting hearts in another Muslim country! Pray that God will begin to open and prepare every heart that will hear her speak.

You Don't Have to be a Genius

So many Christians don't have the courage to get out and minister to others. They feel like an important Bible school or college education would make them more adequate to be God's hand or heart in the lives of others. I have certainly found that isn't true! Even the disciples are an example. I believe there were only two educated ones....Paul and Luke!

I will be 74 years old in February. I have about 18 months of college and yet without a full education or ministry experience, God has consistently called me to minister. When I found myself alone about 25 years ago, God began to whisper to my heart, "Come grow old with ME, the best is yet to be." It was so hard for me to believe that, but He was absolutely right!


He has kept me so busy that I haven't had time to think about the education I didn't have a chance to finish. What matters to the world matters so very little to God.

God Asks us to Die to Self...

What Does That Look Like?

I don't know about you, but dying to self has always been a struggle for me. If I really think about it deeply...I go too far to the extreme. If I'm not so intense about it, I think of doing it in a very superficial way. The list below has really helped me. Not that I'm so good at it, but I certainly understand it better. The list was anonymously written.

It's also important to remember not to do these things like a doormat. Until we are strong enough to do them out of strength and choice...we will not do them for the right reason. God wants us to die to self out of choice and with joy in pleasing HIm!

- 1. When you are forgotten or neglected and you don't hurt with the insult, but your heart is happy--that is dying to self.
- 2. When your advice is disregarded, your opinions ridiculed, and you refuse to let anger rise in your heart, and take it all in patient, loving silence--that is dying to self.

- 3. When you lovingly and patiently bear disorder, irregularity, tardiness, and annoyance...and endure it as Jesus endured it-that is dying to self.
- 4. When you never care to refer to yourself in conversation or record your own good works, or itch for praise after an accomplishment, when you can truly love to be unknown--that is dying to self.
- 5. When you can see your brother or sister prosper and can honestly rejoice with him/ her and feel no envy even though your needs are greater--that is dying to self.
- 6. When you are content with any good, any offering, any raiment, any climate, or any society--that is dying to self.
- 7. When you can take correction, when you can humbly submit inwardly as well as outwardly, with no rebelllion or rersentment rising up within your heart--that is dying to self.

A Prayer Director Visit ...

Some of our prayer directors are involved in other ministries. Some have full-time jobs in the market place of business. I hope this will tell you a bit about two of my favorite people, Annie and Rex Lynch. Annie is one of the first eight women I prayed with when God called me into the emotional healing prayer ministry. That was in 1979. She and husband Rex are sheer joy to me!

Rex and I felt God telling us to leave our home, give away our possessions, and leave 20 years of pastoring and go where He would lead us. That began with a year in Kona Hawaii with YWAM. We traveled to New Zealand to take a Discipleship Training School which all missionaries with YWAM are required to do.

We chose Father's Love Crossroads because it was what God had been doing in our hearts for 20 years.

We minister on a small base in a rural town surrounded with cattle and sheep. Oxford is a little known town to the world but a well known town to Father God. In a two story house on the property over I00 years ago, an anglican vicar prayed that this land would be used to send young people into the world with the gospel of Jesus Christ. He didn't live to see the fulfillment of that prayer, but every year for the past I8 years young and old people have been trained and sent to the nations from this little base. Rex and I have been involved in five Fathers Love Schools since coming here in 2012 staffing and leading 4 of them. We started another one on March 12 of this year. Our school has taught students from America, Canada, England, Germany, Austria, Finland, Sweden, Holland, Denmark Switzerland, Turkey, Thailand, Korea, Pakistan, Costa Rica, and New Zealand. We have students from the ages of 20 to 75. Each school we lead has different speakers speaking on many topics from: The Father Heart of God, and Evangelism, to Hearing Gods Voice and Relationships.

In the photo below you will see a picture taken when Annie and Rex made a trip to the Dallas area. We always have a delightful visit that lasts for hours and hours. (We could use days!) What a joy to hear all that God is doing through YWAM. I am so very proud of my spiritual daughter!
