I explained to him the commission God had given me was to pray with Christians. He gave that some thought and then told me he felt I should really consider praying with groups of Muslim women. Would I pray about it? With some hesitation, I agreed. What happened next was a really shock to me. The first time I prayed asking if the Lord wanted me to do this, I felt He said to me, "A different time. A different people."

When I Asked God Again

The second time I prayed, He seemed to be saying, "What did I do?" I thought, "Well, You healed the sick and delivered those bound by the enemy." He replied, "Did I ask them if they were truly my followers, if they truly believed in me? No. I simply showed them what I could lovingly do for them. Go, and do the same." Now it was time for me to act upon what I believed He said to me.

We decided to put together two small groups of Muslim women. One group was taken from among the widowed Syrian women whose husbands had been killed, often by the military. The second group would be women whose husbands had divorced them. Usually, it was because they had not produced sons for them.

We would spend about two hours with each group. First, I explained to them that only Jesus could walk back with them to give and receive forgiveness, for He is the Lord of forgiveness.

I asked each one to share their story. Hanan felt they would not share as it was not the Arab way. However, miraculously, every woman shared her own experience. They told about the agony when their husbands were killed by the government troops, often right in front of their family's eyes. So many heart breaking stories.

I explained that each was to sit in a chair facing the wall about 8 feet from the lady next to them. They could speak out loud, in a whisper, or

simply in their hearts. I asked them to picture both the Lord and the husband they lost, as they remembered him. Then, I explained they were to be honest and say everything to their husband they never had a chance to say. This was very important as Muslim women were never able to say what they really thought or felt, fearing abuse.

God will not always lead us in the same way He has in the past. He is looking for a flexible people.

I don't know about you, but I am not flexible by nature. There is just something very comfortable about having things stay the same, so it is a shock when the Lord manages to get my attention and asks me to change in certain situations. Then the miracle really comes when He can make my heart willing to respond!

Now was the time to be open and to share their hearts whether it was anger, hatred, despair, vengefulness, or betrayal.

Then, it was time to forgive and ask to be forgiven, explaining to that husband the issues they were forgiving and those for which they were asking his forgiveness. I assured them that Jesus would take their hands and walk with them and there was nothing to fear.

We gave them each a box of tissue. I sat at the front of the room and prayed with all my heart for them to be able to really meet Jesus in this

way.

They spent almost an hour crying and talking to that husband as they remembered him and then each came back to our half circle in the front of the room. There were lots of hugs (which is not the Arab culture) both for me and for each other. It was such a beautiful time.

I felt the Lord saying, "You just bring them to me every time you can and I will do the rest."

What a shock! The adventure with Christ Jesus is so beautiful and unexpected if we will just let Him speak into every situation. I believe He will surprise us again and again. Seeing the results, I don't think we will ever be disappointed!

FULL-TIME, SHORT-TERM MISSIONARY TESTIMONY

Years ago through a series of life circumstances and a Bible study that I was attending, I felt that God was calling me to be a full-time, short-term missionary.

We moved recently, and so a few months ago I was on mission to the new dry cleaners. While I was in there I heard a foreign language movie playing on her computer.

So I asked,

"What language is that movie in?"

She said, "Hindi"

"Oh are you from India?"

"No Tanzania."

"Well what language do you speak?"

"Swahili. But I also speak 12 other languages."

I was pretty impressed by that since I only speak English and a little bit of Pig Latin.

And not wanting to waste this opportunity I said, "I am very interested in languages too. In fact I am involved with a movie that has been translated into over 1400 different languages. I can send you that movie in any language you want right now. Would you like to have it?" con't p5

I began to develop a relationship with Rose, and one day I ask her if she would like to do a Bible study with me and she said yes. Then I gave her a study Bible with her name on it.

A few weeks later I shared the gospel with her and she prayed to receive Christ. Since then we have continued meeting regularly at her cleaners for Bible Study and prayer. I am so excited about discipling Rose and watching the Lord work in her life.

In Philippians 1:12, Paul said, "My circumstances have

served to advance the gospel."

You and I have been uniquely placed by God because people will seek God and find him right where they are and right where we are. (see Acts 17: 24-27)

So those neighbors of yours, God is not far from them because YOU live next door. That nurse at YOUR doctor's office, God is not far from her because YOU got the flu. And that Mom with the crying baby sitting next to you on that airplane, God is not far from her because you got stuck in the middle seat. That tech at YOUR vet, God is not far from her because YOUR cat's got fleas. And that Muslim woman at YOUR cleaners—God is not far from her because YOU take YOUR clothes there.

I challenge all of you to begin thinking of yourselves as Full Time Short Term Missionaries too, and watch to see how God will use YOUR circumstances to advance the gospel. Ordinary events are never coincidental or incidental in the lives of God's people. Your mission field is the space between your own 2 feet. ALL things are His servants. He can use anything. Question is: "Will it be YOU?"
